1. **Only the first letter** of your names and citizenship is capitalized
2. Mobile phone number should start **with your country code** (e.g., 82, South Korea)
3. **“History” item** asks if you have received the POSCO scholarship before. If you have, highlight **“Continuous”**, if you have not, highlight **“New”**.
4. For **“GPA (Scale)” item**, you are asked to write your GPA in **the most recent semester**, in principle. You can write **CGPA** in case your university adopts it, instead of GPA. Enquire which your university takes to the person in charge at your university.
