Subject: 15th Maharashtra State Inter University Youth Festival 'Indradhanushya 2 017'

A State Level Inter-University Competition 'Indradhanushya' is organized by the office of Hon. Chancellor every year. This year the competition is being organized at Vasantrao Naik Marathwada Krishi Veedyapeeth, Parbhani during November 5-9, 2017. During this, various competitions in Theater, Music, Dance, Literature, and Fine Arts are conducted. We are in the process of finalizing the team of students, enrolled with this University, to be sent for the competition to represent Dr. BATU. The process of selection is as follows:

- 1. The student/s will send the video clip/photographs of his/her activity.
- 2. The experts and the Cultural Committee of Dr. BATU will evaluate these clips or photographs and select the students.
- 3. In some cases, if required, the students may have to appear for a final round which will be conducted at the University Main Campus at Lonere.
- 4. The final selection will be intimated to the students through whats app message/email.

The general rules for the evaluation process are as follows:

- 1. Students participating should be a regular student of college and course (and year of study i.e. only first year B.Tech/M. Tech/B. Pharm/M. Pharm/B. Arch/ M. Arch in case of affiliated colleges) affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological University or at its Main Campus at Lonere for the Academic Year 2017-18.
- 2. The entries should be sent electronically to whats app no: 8830780939 or email id: cultural@dbatu.ac.in
- 3. The students have to submit a scanned copy of certificate by the Principal/Director/Head of the institute/college as mentioned in Annexure -I attached on the college/institute letterhead with seal. Without this the entry will not be valid.
- 4. The entries should reach to us electronically on or before Tuesday October 17, 2017.
- 5. A student can participate in more than one events. In such case he/she should send a separate mail mentioning the various events in which he/she has participated. More chances are there for such students for selection. The reason is, we can send a team of maximum 38 students. Secondly, such students also have a possibility to win the prize of 'Golden Boy/Girl' during the actual event.
- 6. The **expenses** made for preparations the selection process **are to be borne by the institute/candidate** and no reimbursement will be made against it from the university.

- 7. The institute/candidates have to bear the expenses towards traveling, lodging and boarding for the final selection round to be conducted at Dr. BATU Lonere, if required.
- 8. The students have to ensure the quality of the media sent for selection process. The university is not responsible for any problems related to the quality of media.
- 9. The selected candidates for the final round will be informed on mail/whats app.
- 10. The evaluation will be done through the external experts, and the committee members of cultural committee of Dr. BATU. The decision taken by them will be final.
- 11. The **selected candidates** of some of the events will have to come to main campus of University at Lonere and **stay here for a period of about 7 days**, for the practice sessions, before the actual date of event.

You are requested to circulate the information amongst the students and send the video clips/photographs as per the details given in Annexure –II, on or before Tuesday Oct 17, 2017.
