Item No. 4: To approve Academic Quality Assurance Reports 2017-18 and 2018-19

AC asked the IQAC cell to call the meeting of cell as early as possible and place the matter in the next meeting of AC.

Item No. 5: To approve the Course Structure and Syllabi for various B.Tech programs in Engineering

The BoS of respective departments of University has conducted Curriculum Development Workshops during 13th Nov. 2019 to 7th Dec. 2019 for all B.Tech programs. For the development of curriculum, experts from IIT, NIT and Industry were invited in addition to BoS members and faculty members of affiliated institutions. To bring uniformity across all disciplines of B.Tech programs the fixed course structure was given to each department. Each BoS was asked to provide list of courses for Majors and Minors. AC members requested to reduce eligibility requirement of Majors and Minors to 75% instead of CGPA of 8.0.

Accordingly every BoS has developed the course structures and submitted to AC. The AC approved the curriculum of the first year which is going to be started from Academic Year 2020-21. AC also approved the eligibility requirement of Majors and Minors to 75% at the end of 4th semester, instead of CGPA of 8.0.

However, before taking final call from second year onwards AC decided to form committee of following members to take a review of the same.

Item No. 7: Implementation of "Carry on" in terms of heads of passing only

In 13th AC meeting it was decided to keep the term and promotion to the higher class in terms of % of Credits, however, this method was leading to problem when resulting % of credits founds to be fractional. Therefore, it was resolved to use the number of heads of passing instead of percentage of credits. A student with maximum backlogs of 5 courses (theory and lab together) till the immediate previous semester (second term) may claim promotion to higher class.

Resolution: After due deliberations, it was resolved to adopt the promotion rules in terms of number of heads of passing as given below:

1. Fist year student should not carry more than five heads of passing (theory and Lab) for promotion to the Second Year.

- 2. Second year student should not carry more than five heads of passing (theory and Lab) promotion to the Third Year.
- 3. Third year student should not carry more than five heads of passing (theory and Lab) promotion to the Final Year.

This will be effective from current academic year 2019-20, for I,II,III & IV year B.Tech programs.

- Item No. 8: To inform status of affiliation for the year 2019-20 in the Faculty of Engineering and Technology, Architecture, Pharmacy and Hotel Management and Catering Technology.
 - a) Report on ongoing and completed Affiliation process for the 2019-20.

Dr. P. V. Vijay Babu presented the status of affiliation for the year 2020-21 in the Faculty of Engineering and Technology, Architecture, Pharmacy and Hotel Management and Catering Technology. Affiliation process for A Y 2020-21 was started by publishing a Notification on 15th Oct 2019. Till date 10 new proposals (09 Pharm + 01 Engg) are received by the University for the Affiliation. Hon vice chancellor expressed his appreciation for achievement of having been selected as high performing Affiliating Technical Universities for additional funding.

Item No. 10: Any other point with permission of Chair

• Reduction in intake of Department of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering:

Department of Electronics and Telecommunication (E & TC) Engineering of Dr. B.A.T.U. Lonere is running UG, PG and Ph.D Programmes with six regular faculty against the sanctioned intake of twelve. From academic year 2008-2009, the intake of E & TC department was increased from 60 to 120, but additional faculty required for increase in intake is not yet sanctioned by the Govt. of Maharashtra till date.

As per AICTE's Faculty Student ratio, the department is in need of thirty faculty members, to run the UG Programme smoothly. In such a situation, with available regular faculties it is difficult to carryout academic activities of the department. Therefore, with intake of 120 and 18 at UG and PG level respectively, the exiting faculty, supporting staff and infrastructure is highly inadequate to run these Programmes smoothly. Considering the fact, it is requested to reduce intake from 120 to 90 from the Academic Year 2020-21.

AC discussed the matter at length resolved to reduce intake to 90.

• Action regard to ICT initiatives

The higher education system continues to face the challenges of expansion, inclusion and excellence in education. The AC suggested to have involvement and necessary action is required from University and affiliated colleges for enhancing the digital initiatives.

SWAYAM, SWAYAM *PRABHA*,32 High Quality Educational Channels through DTH across the country on 24X7 basis, National digital library, Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching

(ARPIT), Digi locker, Free /libre and open Source Software for education (FOSSEE) Baadal - Central Cloud Infrastructure are some of the initiative will be pursued at University and affiliated colleges. For more details on these initiatives refer Annexure-A.

In order to maintain confidentiality and avoid undue practices AC authorize Hon. Vice-Chancellor for nomination of Expert and Selection Committee members.

Resolution : The Academic Council after due discussion resolved to authorize the Chairman, Hon. Vice-Chancellor, for choosing and forming the Expert Committee/ Selection Committee members for the Recruitment of Administrative Positions of University and Faculty Positions for University Departments and Principals of Affiliated Institutions, in view of confidentiality to be maintained and to avoid undue practices that may arise otherwise.
