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Dean Academic (F-E&T) welcomed all the members of the Academic Council and requested Hon. Vice-Chancellor to start the meeting.

Item No.1: Approval of minutes of 23rd Meeting of AC

Minutes were circulated to all the members for their suggestions, if any. Review of 23rd Minutes of Academic Council Meetings was done. No suggestions were received.

Resolutions: After due discussions and deliberations, all the members of Academic Council approved the minutes of the 23rd Academic council meetings.

Item No.2: Reopening of University activities as per the Government Guidelines.

Standard Operating Procedure/Guidelines for Reopening of institutes in the context of Covid-19 Pandemic AY 2020-21 were decided as follows:

- Permission from local Authority
- Starting of classes in Phase-wise manner in Physical mode:
 - Phase-I: Final Year Practical in Batch-wise (15th Feb-28th Feb)
 - Phase-II: Third Year Practical in Batch-wise (1st March – 15th March)

- Phase-III: Second Year Practical (16th March-31st March)
- Phase-IV: Classes by dividing students in 2 Division (1st April onwards)
- Screening of each student at entry gate every day by Thermal Scanner.
- Avoid unnecessary gathering of students at Entry/exit gates, Canteen, Washrooms and Corridors.
- Use of the face cover/masks to be made mandatory in the College Campus.
- Use of alcohol-based hand sanitization should be done whenever feasible.
- Frequent hand washing with soap even when hands are visibly not dirty.
- Physical distancing at least 6 feet to be followed while communicating with each other.
- Use the drinking water from your own bottle only.
- Don't exchange your Textbooks, Notebooks, Eatables, any other Stationary with your friends in the Class/College.
- Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
- Keep measured distancing between two Vehicles at the vehicles parking stand in the College.
- Keep the College surroundings and Washrooms/Lavatories neat & clean.
- Respiratory Etiquettes to be strictly followed. It involves strict practice of covering one's mouth/nose while coughing/sneezing with tissue / handkerchief / flexed elbow and disposing of used tissue properly.
- Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App may be advised.
- Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earlie contact on mobile number of your class counselor/ Class Teacher.
- Students are advised to seat one on each dual desk.
- E-Library facility should be made available to students.
- Regular sanitization of Classrooms /Laboratory/Library/Canteen/Corridors.
- There should not be compulsion for 75% attendance of students.
- Both online as well as offline mode attendance should be considered in the favor of students.
- Electrical safety audit of College buildings and Hostels should be done by appropriate agency.
- For Completion of Syllabus in stipulated time microplanning of timetable for both online and offline mode should be done and strictly observed.
- No compulsion should be made to students and staff residing in containment zone.
- Pandemic Act-1897 and Disaster Management Act-2005 should be strictly followed.

Resolution: After due discussions and deliberations, all the members of Academic Council approved the Standard Operating Procedure/Guidelines for Reopening of institutes in the

context of Covid-19 Pandemic AY 2020-21 as stated above.

- Liaisoning with industry/research organizations etc.
- Budget allocation for the Research in the annual budget for the institute
- Any Other Relevant Point

The final report of the Committee is expected within a week. The information is being presented for the kind information of the Academic Council.

3. All Ph.D students should present their Research Proposal Seminar (Registration Seminar) within First Three Semesters. One year relaxation may be given for this as per rule if permitted by AC to do so.
