In case of reviewer role, he/she must maintain communication with the Translator, conduct weekly follow-ups on completed translation work, and ensure the review process is completed according to the norms which will be communicated in mail after selection.

Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological University may assign one or more translators to a single book. The decision of DBATU regarding the assignment or removal of translators or reviewers, depending on quality of the translation work, will be final.
