NOTIFICATION

Subject: Extension of the maximum permissible period for completion of the three-year Diploma programme up to seven (7) years under Rule 6.10 — approval of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

Reference:

1. Rule 6.10 of the Diploma Examination Rules and Regulations of the University.
2. Letter of the Controller of Examinations, dated 31.07.2026.
3. Approval of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor conveyed through the Registrar, dated 03.08.2026.

All the **Heads of Departments** of the three-year Diploma programme are hereby informed that Rule 6.10 of the Diploma Examination Rules and Regulations provides that *"in special cases the Vice-Chancellor may, on the recommendation of the Department and the DPEC, further extend the total time limit for completion of all the requirements up to seven (7) years for the Diploma programme of three-year duration."*

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, in exercise of the special power so vested, has been pleased to **approve extension of the total time limit for completion of all requirements of the three-year Diploma programme up to seven (7) years**, so as to avoid academic loss to students who have been unable to clear their remaining backlogs within the normal maximum period of six (6) years.

Accordingly, the following is notified for information, compliance and wide circulation among the students concerned:

1. Batch admitted to First Year in AY 2020–21 (six-year period ended with Summer 2026)

Students of this batch are **permitted one additional academic year**, i.e. up to and including the **Summer 2027 examination**, to complete all remaining course requirements/backlogs of the Diploma programme.

2. Batch admitted to First Year in AY 2019–20 (six-year period ended with Summer 2025)

These students were in their **seventh year during AY 2025–26**. Their performance in the Winter 2025 and Summer 2026 examinations shall accordingly be considered as valid and within the permissible period, and results shall be processed and declared by the Examination Section.

The **Summer 2026 examination shall be the terminal examination** for this batch. No examination opportunity beyond Summer 2026 is available to them, the outer limit of seven years having been reached.

3. Nature of the extension

The extension is to a **maximum total period of seven (7) years** reckoned from the date of first registration to the First Year of the Diploma programme. It is not an additional year over and above seven years. **No further extension beyond seven years is permissible** under the Rules, and no such request shall be entertained.

4. Departmental and DPEC recommendation (mandatory)

As Rule 6.10 requires the recommendation of the Department and the DPEC in each case, all Heads of Departments are requested to forward to this office, **on or before 15th August 2026**, a departmental statement of eligible students in the following format:

The consolidated statement will be placed before the DPEC for ratification. Cases not so forwarded and recommended will not be processed.

5. Examination registration

Students covered by Clause 1 who could not register for the Summer 2026 or earlier examinations on account of having exhausted the six-year period shall be permitted to register for the **Winter 2026 examination**. Registration shall be at the prescribed fee; no penalty on account of the earlier lapse shall be levied.

6. Lateral entry / Direct Second Year admissions

Rule 6.10 as quoted above applies to the Diploma programme of **three-year duration**. Cases of students admitted through lateral entry / direct second year shall be regulated by the corresponding provision applicable to them.

7. Consequence of non-completion

Students who fail to complete all requirements of the Diploma programme within the extended period of seven years as above shall **stand terminated from the programme** in terms of Rule 6.10, and no further representation in this regard shall be considered.
